Our Quality Management Systems are designed to meet the requirements of ISO 9001:2015 and BRCGS Packaging Materials Issue 6 - providing the framework through which the process of Review and Continual Improvement is implemented. The objectives of our Product Safety & Quality Management Systems are;

- To manufacture and supply product that is consistent with the customer's specific requirements, within Statutory and Regulatory limits.
- Maintain security and control of both Technical and Manufactured work & our premises throughout our Quality Systems.
- Ensure our premises are adapted, maintained and operated so as to avoid contamination, minimise environmental deterioration and permit effective cleaning.
- Effectively train all our personnel in the Company's requirements to adopt Food Safety practices and pay due regard to Personnel Hygiene.
- Using Corrective and Preventive Actions and reviewing their effectiveness to continually Improve Product Safety & Quality standards and thereby increase profitability.

The above quality objectives are determined by the Directors and Senior Management, communicated throughout the company, and reviewed periodically at Senior Management meetings and Management Review meetings.

We therefore pledge to supply Safe and Legal Products (when used solely for their intended purpose) to our customers.

To ensure that we meet our Product Safety related duties and responsibilities, we are **currently certificated** to the **BRCGS Packaging Materials Issue 6.** This **Product Safety & Quality Policy** is complementary to any other Systems in operation across the business.
